

Activity 1 - Number Music

- Take time to develop the bowing technique, ensuring that pupils can play a range of dynamics
- The faster you bow the louder the sound.
- Try passing the bowed notes around the class using a range of dynamics

Activity 2 - Chord Progression

- Compose a simple chord pattern
- Move between each chord within your pattern together
- Play your chord progression in smaller groups
- You may wish to experiment with creating a complex chord pattern

Activity 3 - Ensemble

- Simply tap on a stringed instrument image to 'ghost' it. The strings highlighted will sound when you play the chord bars

Activity 3 - Accompaniment

- The autoplay string patches are a great place to start.
- Use the auto-drums to provide extra rhythm
- You may wish to assign autoplay instruments to musicians in your group

Activity 3 - Additional Activities

- There are multiple techniques to play the strings. Bowed, Pizzicato and Staccato
- Play a progression implementing these techniques
- Assign different techniques to musicians in your group
